We had 4 teams out again this year at the Calderdale Way Relay, Men's Open, Women's, Mixed and Men's Vets.

A large proportion of the runners were Vets with the Men's team 6<sup>th</sup> overall, the Ale Stars (Vets) were 28<sup>th</sup> (5<sup>th</sup> Vets) & the Cote de Holme Moss Massive (Mixed) were 49<sup>th</sup> overall (10<sup>th</sup> Mixed), and the Ladies, who were 31<sup>st</sup> overall, were, 1st Ladies team, beating last year's winners Barlick by nearly 7 minutes! After the initial fast start, she hit the bottom of the steep hill placed within the top 25 and used her climbing strength well to reach the top comfortably within the top 20. Her adeptness at descending paid dividends too, overtaking several more competitors to finish a superb 13<sup>th</sup> overall in 34.38, claiming the 1st Lady prize and taking 25 seconds of the course record which had stood since 2007, a fantastic achievement!!
